Follow these tips to ensure your food is always safe to eat.

#### **Fridge storage**

Some foods need to be kept in the fridge to help stop bacteria growing. These include food with a “use by” date, cooked foods and ready to eat food such as a desserts and cooked meat.

Here’s how to prevent bacteria from growing:

- Cool leftovers as quickly as possible (within 90 minutes) and store them in the fridge .Eat them with two days.
- Never put open cans in the fridge. Transfer the contents into a covered bowl.
- Make sure food has cooled down before you put it in the fridge.
- To ensure your fridge remains hygienic and in good working condition, clean it regularly.

#### **“Use by” dates**

No food lasts forever, however well it is stored. Most pre-packed foods carry either a ‘use by’ or ‘best before’ date.

\*’Use by’ dates appear on foods that go off quickly. It can be dangerous to eat foods past this date.

\*’Best before’ dates are for foods with a longer life. They show how long the food will be at its best quality.
